## Clarence Dodge Scholarship Program 2012

Local 521 will award up to ten scholarships in the name of Legacy Local 715's late and beloved first union president, Clarence "Duke" Dodge. This program awards up to ten \$1,500 scholarships. To be eligible, applicants must:



Be a Local 521 member or child(ren) of a Local 521 member (grandchildren and spouses are not eligible). Membership must be for two continuous years as of September 1, 2012. However, if the chapter has not been in existence for two years, the member must have been a member in continued good standing for the entire time since affiliation.



Graduate from high school or a GED program by August, 2011, and be enrolled as a college freshman by fall semester of 2012, **or** be a current undergraduate student. (This scholarship is not available to graduate students.)



Attend a four-year accredited undergraduate college or university, or a junior college with a track to a four-year college and a class load of at least 9 units. Correspondence and trade school students may also apply.



Submit a verification of grade-point average and a letter of recommendation from the school counselor, principal or administrator.

Submit a 250 word essay describing career goals, relationship to the union and labor movement, and why you deserve a Local 521 scholarship. This essay may be published in part or full if applicant is awarded a scholarship.

All applications will be screened to ensure they meet the eligibility requirements.

**The deadline to apply is March 31, 2012.** Scholarship recipients will be announced in May, 2012, and awards will be mailed directly to the recipients in August.

(Local 521 officers and staff and their families are not eligible.)
