

MEETING MINUTES
MAY 4, 2016

- I. Call To Order:** the meeting was called to order by Chair Lorenzo Lambaren 6:15 PM by Chair Lorenzo Lambaren.
- II. Welcome and Introductions:** Chair Lambaren extended a welcome to all in attendance. Everyone introduced themselves.

- III. Treasurer's Report:** Chair Lambaren reported as of March 31, 2016 there is a balance of \$5,189.49. He stated there is a charge of \$53.80 that was charged for a meeting expense in San Jose. Chair Lambaren stated that there is still the following donation requests were still pending: \$200 to Mi Familia Vota and \$200 to American Indian Veteran's Association (AVIA). There is also a pending line item of \$100 for the NAMI Walk on May 21, 2016. There may also be pending food expenses.

Motion passed as presented.*

Press Conference April 18, 2016: Chair Lambaren reported that at the press conference held that date regarding the arguments before the U.S. Supreme Court regarding DAPA/DACA the same day He and Sergio Garcia were featured on the news reports. He hopes that this will start a conversation regarding DAPA/DACA with people who saw them on the news.
Mi Familia Vota --- Sam Molina: Sam Molina reported that Giselle Gasca has become Regional Co-Ordinator for Fresno. This will free more time for him to focus on other areas of California as he is the California State Director for Mi Familia Vota. He thanked Sergio Garcia for his help in gathering signatures for various issues and Lorenzo Lambaren for his help on the Citizenship Workshop held at Roosevelt High School April 16, 2016.
Future Donations: Chair Lambaren stated that the caucus look into events/groups/donations the Caucus has made in the past. He stated that he would obtain an update on Joven Noble.
