### COMPLETE THE FREE FAFSA

Complete the form online: [FAFSA.ed.gov](http://FAFSA.ed.gov)  
Eastern Gateway Community College school code: **007275**  
The FAFSA application is a requirement. If it's determined that you are not eligible for federal or state financial aid, a "last-dollar" scholarship will be applied to your remaining balance for tuition, fees and e-books. Your FAFSA may be chosen for additional verification by the Dept. of Education. Compliance is required to receive the scholarship. Your enrollment advisor can help you with the process.

### SUBMIT YOUR TRANSCRIPTS

Submit your high school transcript or GED test score as proof of high school completion. If you have completed any college coursework, have the transcript sent to EGCC. Applicable college credits will be transferred to the new program.
