Kent Wong is Director of the UCLA Labor Center, where he teaches courses in labor studies and Asian American studies. He previously served as staff attorney for the Service Employees International Union (SEIU). He was the founding President of the Asian Pacific American Labor Alliance, the founding President of the United Association for Labor Education, and currently is Vice President of the California Federation of Teachers. The UCLA Labor Center sponsors 300 student internships each year placing them in cutting edge labor and community organizations throughout the country.
