A Simple Application Process

You can apply for admission online in a matter of minutes by visiting www.wgu.edu/hcap and clicking on the "Apply Now" button. You can also call a WGU Enrollment Counselor toll free at **1-866-225-5948** to learn more.

Typically, within a week of receiving your application, WGU will contact you regarding the status of your application and answer any questions you may have. If you are accepted, you will schedule an Intake Interview to review your degree program as well as address your questions and concerns prior to finalizing your enrollment. Programs begin the first of every month.

Tuition That's Affordable

- Nursing Programs: \$3,250 per 6-month term
- B.S. Nursing (Prelicensure): \$4,250 per 6-month term
- Application Fee: \$65
- Resource Fee: \$145 per 6-month term
- Other fees may apply depending on program choice
