SEIU 521 Convention - Key Dates

July 25: Nomination petitions must be postmarked by July 25 and received by the union office no later than 5 p.m. on July 31, 2017.

July 31, 5 p.m.: Deadline to hand deliver nomination petitions to SEIU 521 offices. No exceptions.

August 1-31: Voting dates, times, and locations will be announced by Chapter.

October 13-15: The convention will be held at SEIU 521 Headquarters in San Jose.
