SEIU 521 REGION 3 VICE PRESIDENT



Duties of SEIU Local 521 Regional Vice Presidents—(SEIU 521 Localwide Bylaws, Article IX):

Section 8: The Regional Vice Presidents shall assist the President in affairs of the Local Union and perform such duties as may be assigned to them by the Executive Board and President from time to time. The Regional Vice Presidents shall, advocate on behalf of the Chapters, Industry Councils and Caucuses in their geographical area and may convene appropriate meetings of those groups. Each Regional Vice President shall give a full, written report of his/her activities at each regular Executive Board meeting, at his/her regional leadership and/or regional membership meetings and the Local Union Convention. He or she is a voting member on the Executive Board.

TERM OF OFFICE: Expires March 1, 2028.

REQUIREMENTS for consideration for appointment to Region 3 Vice President:

- Must be a member of SEIU Local 521 in good standing, paying full membership dues, for at least two continuous years immediately prior to nomination for appointment with no felony conviction.
- The applicants for Region 3 Vice President **must be represented by SEIU Local 521 in the Local's jurisdiction they will serve.** (Region 3 VP applicants are employed in Stanislaus, Tuolumne, Mariposa, Mono, Alpine, Merced Counties.)

TO APPLY:

- Submit your request for consideration for appointment as Region 3 Vice President to the SEIU Local 521 Executive Board no later than **3:00 p.m., Wednesday, June 17, 2026.**
- Include in your request: your full name (printed), your chapter and your contact information (address, phone number, and e-mail address).
- Optional Inclusion: A 75-word (maximum) statement of your qualifications for the Office of Regional Vice President.

APPOINTMENT PROCESS:

At the in-person Executive Board meeting in Fresno on Saturday, June 27, 2026, the Board will vote on which qualified candidate(s) they feel will best represent our Local as Region 3 VP. All qualified applicants will be reviewed by the Board prior to the meeting. Candidates must be present at the in-person Executive Board meeting in Fresno to be considered for the positions. Those chosen will be sworn-in and begin serving at this meeting.
